A Letter from Rev. Beverly A. Bartlett

Dear Friends,

We are excited to welcome Chesna Hinkley back this week. As was announced earlier this summer, Chesna will be here for the next year as our Director of Christian Education and Outreach Ministries. Chesna's primary responsibilities with Christian Education are for our children's programs, but she will be working closely with April Martin, helping with confirmation, youth and young adult ministries as well. She'll also be joining some of our adult education programs and may do some teaching there as the year progresses. She'll also be staffing the Outreach Ministries and Evangelism committees. We are so glad you are back with us this year, Chesna!

In other exciting news--the ramp renovation is complete!! If your walks take you by the church, please take note of the new ramp entrance. The doors are now automated, which will make entrance for those using strollers, walkers, scooters, and wheelchairs much easier. We have been anticipating this renovation for a few years now, and it is wonderful to finally have it done. Here is a photo of the new entrance:



As I'm sure you have all heard, the NYC public schools have delayed their opening. The independent schools have their own individual plans, with some children returning full-time, others part-time, and others 100% remote. It is a stressful time for families and educators, and anyone who is figuring how to return to a workplace safely--so remember to be patient and kind with yourselves and each other.

As far as the church buildings are concerned, we have implemented new safety practices: up stairwells and down stairwells, one-way entrances and exits, limited elevator occupancy, hand sanitizer stations and bottles all over the place, lots of disinfecting and cleaning, physical distancing dots on the floor of the lobby for drop-off and stencils on the sidewalk for people waiting to enter the building, procuring air purifiers, installing new filters in the HVAC system, keeping windows open, checking everyone's temperature as they enter and having them attest to their health status, and making sure we have lots of face masks on hand. Our primary focus is getting the day school up and running with adequate safety protocols in place. I know some of your are eager to return to the sanctuary for worship, while many do not feel it is safe to do so yet. Please know that the Building Reopening Task Force continues to have conversations about when and how we may be able to offer in-person worship, but we do not have any decisions yet. As schools and

universities start up and more people return to the city, we will see what the numbers do this fall.

Have a safe Labor Day weekend. I'll leave you with a couple of verses from this Sunday's passage from Romans 13:9-10:

"The commandments, "You shall not commit adultery; You shall not murder; You shall not steal; You shall not covet"; and any other commandment, are summed up in this word, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore, love is the fulfilling of the law." May we strive to live in love, with all its complicated demands and challenges,
